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Marriage Ministry Trends

- Most engaged couples are cohabitating and contracepting before they enter into marriage preparation.
- The majority of couples who come through marriage preparation still go on to choose contraception over NFP.
- The most commonly cited reason for rejecting NFP is that it is perceived to be too difficult to use, due to abstinence and the time commitment involved to learn a method.



Statistics

- Only 8 % of American Catholics agree with the Church's teaching on contraception.
- An estimated 55% of teens have had intercourse by the age of 18.
- 99% of sexually experienced female teens use some form of contraception.
- The average age of first exposure to pornography is 11 years old.
- 75% of parents in the survey thought their child hadn't seen pornography online, but in reality, 53% of their children reported that they had in fact seen it.



Parents Looking for Help

- Authentically Catholic Sex Education
- Formation for parents and children on internet safety, the dangers of social media and pornography
- Formation for students on social, emotional, and physical health and selfcare
- Support for parents on how to talk with their children about these topics

THE LEGACY PATH

A discipleship strategy that equips parents to be the primary faith influencers in their family that is based on 7 milestones that every person experiences in his/her growth in Christ. https://legacymilestones.com/

Each Milestone includes

- 1. A designated church leader that accompanies parents of kids working toward that milestone
- 2. A parent seminar specific to each milestone to equip parents for that stage
- 3. Core competencies (key truths learned as he/she progresses from one milestone to next)
- 4. Faith Talks (ways in which core competencies are reinforced in formal and informal ways by parents)
- 5. A church event to celebrate reaching the milestone or a Family Celebration marking the milestone

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Sexuality Teaching in the context of Adult Responsibility





Teen STAR

- Catholic formation on human sexuality for teens that partners with parents.
- Developmental curriculum utilizes experience of the body's fertility patterns to discover values and derive norms.
- Teaching uses the Socratic Method, inviting students into dialogue to arrive at truth.
- Teaches responsible decision-making and communication skills.
- Enhances teens' self-understanding and self-esteem.
- Moves teens from being victims of their hormones to being in control.
- Demands self-discipline which is counter-cultural.
- Offers methods to reject peer, as well as media pressure.
- Affirms virtues but is not moralistic.
- Treats sex as a gift to be respected and valued.



Topics

- Understanding gender and identity
- Social and cultural views of sexuality
- Anatomy, signs of fertility, hormone and brain development
- Decision making
- Sanctity of life
- Relationships: friendship and dating
- Living a moral life (this includes sexual morality, STIs and pornography)



Fruits

- Decrease in teen pregnancies in students enrolled in the program in Chile (study conducted over 4 years)
- <u>Worldwide studies</u> show increased % of students remaining chaste or recommitting to chastity after taking the course
- Reported increase in communication between teens and parents
- Reported improvement in behavioral, social, and academic activity of teens in school settings



From our pilot teachers

- Middle school students are in need of a class that teaches sexuality because of how early they are exposed to such things.
- Teen STAR offers a holistic approach to sexuality and this best reaches the students at the stage of development where they are.
- Furthermore, parents are not discussing this topic with their students. We are not serving our young people if we ignore this need.
- The Socratic method of teaching that is emphasized in Teen STAR is a good way at reaching this age group.
- Most adolescents do not internalize information well if they are being told what to believe; rather it is important for them to wrestle with an idea and to be guided to the truth.
- Teen STAR is not a replacement for Ruah Woods or other TOB programs. It is the perfect complement that builds upon the other programs. Teen STAR is different in that it includes practical application and instruction that is based in science and the students' personal experiences.




Details

- 12 units of study taught at one grade level between 6th 8th and one grade level between 9th-12th
 - Once per week for one semester, daily for one quarter
 - We are recommending the Middle School curriculum, even for high school students.
- Each school/parish should train a male and female teacher
 - Some trained teachers may be available to come to your location and teach for stipend
- Available in Spanish
- Tuition: paid for by the Archdiocese of Detroit
